

Arriving at ESW

Please wear a face covering inside or when working closely with others outside.

Arrive at the start time of your Session (15 minute window).

Entry is via the Main Entrance.

Access to the building is only during pre-booked Sessions.

Wash your hands when arriving at ESW.

Use the automatic hand sanitiser dispensers located in circulation spaces.

Continue to observe physical distancing where possible. We want everyone to be confident they have had no contact with others while here by keeping to the space and time guidelines rigorously.

Please do not enter other areas of the building or outside spaces (other than your work space or booked space) - you may not be aware of standard or new security systems in place in those areas.

Staff members are also observing physical distancing so please keep interactions short.

Kitchen, IT Space and Research Space are not currently available.

Bring drinking water or a water bottle or flask. There is a free water dispenser on Level 0.

The lift should only be used for moving equipment or disabled access.

- Level 1 users: Level 1 toilets.
- Level 0 Workshop Users and Project Space Holders: Level 0 toilets.
- Courtyard and Bays: South Labs toilet.
- North Labs groups: North Labs toilet.
- South Lab Project Space Holders: South Labs toilet.

You can book up to 2 sessions per week. If you need more than that, please speak to a technician.

Arrive with the correct safety equipment, including mask, eye protection and steel toe capped boots.
