- Steel toe cap safety boots
- Overalls - cotton only no polyester blends
- P3 mask is essential for inductions in any space
- Safety glasses
- Ear defenders
- Manual handling gloves
- Long hair tied back and jewellery removed

### For Metal working especially

- Flame retardant overalls are highly recommended
- MIG welding gloves
- TIG welding gloves - ONLY for TIG competent user
- Welding mask - we do have welding masks but it is recommended to get your own so you know it is in full working order and hygiene/Covid safe
